### **Notice of Race (NoR)**

The notation '[NP]' in a rule means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

## **1 RULES**

1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

1.2 Datchet Water Sailing Club also implements the RYA Racing Charter and competitors are expected to sail in accordance with this charter. This can be found at the start of the RYA Rule Book or from [www.rya.org.uk/racingrules](http://www.rya.org.uk/racingrules).

1.3 Racing shall be made in accordance with the rules of the International K1 Class Association. In addition, the by-laws of Datchet Water Sailing Club shall apply to all competitors and support persons.

3.4 [DP] While racing, except in an emergency or where used in relation to GPS tracking facilities, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

## **4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

4.1 The event is open to all boats of the K1 Class.

4.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form and submitting it, together with the required fee, from <https://www.dwsc.co.uk/event/k1-open-meeting--1> by 2<sup>nd</sup> July 2021.

4.3 To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees.

22 RISK STATEMENT

22.1 RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. **Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.**

23 INSURANCE

23.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £2 million per incident or the equivalent.

24 PRIZES

24.1 Prizes will be awarded at the discretion of the Organising Authority.

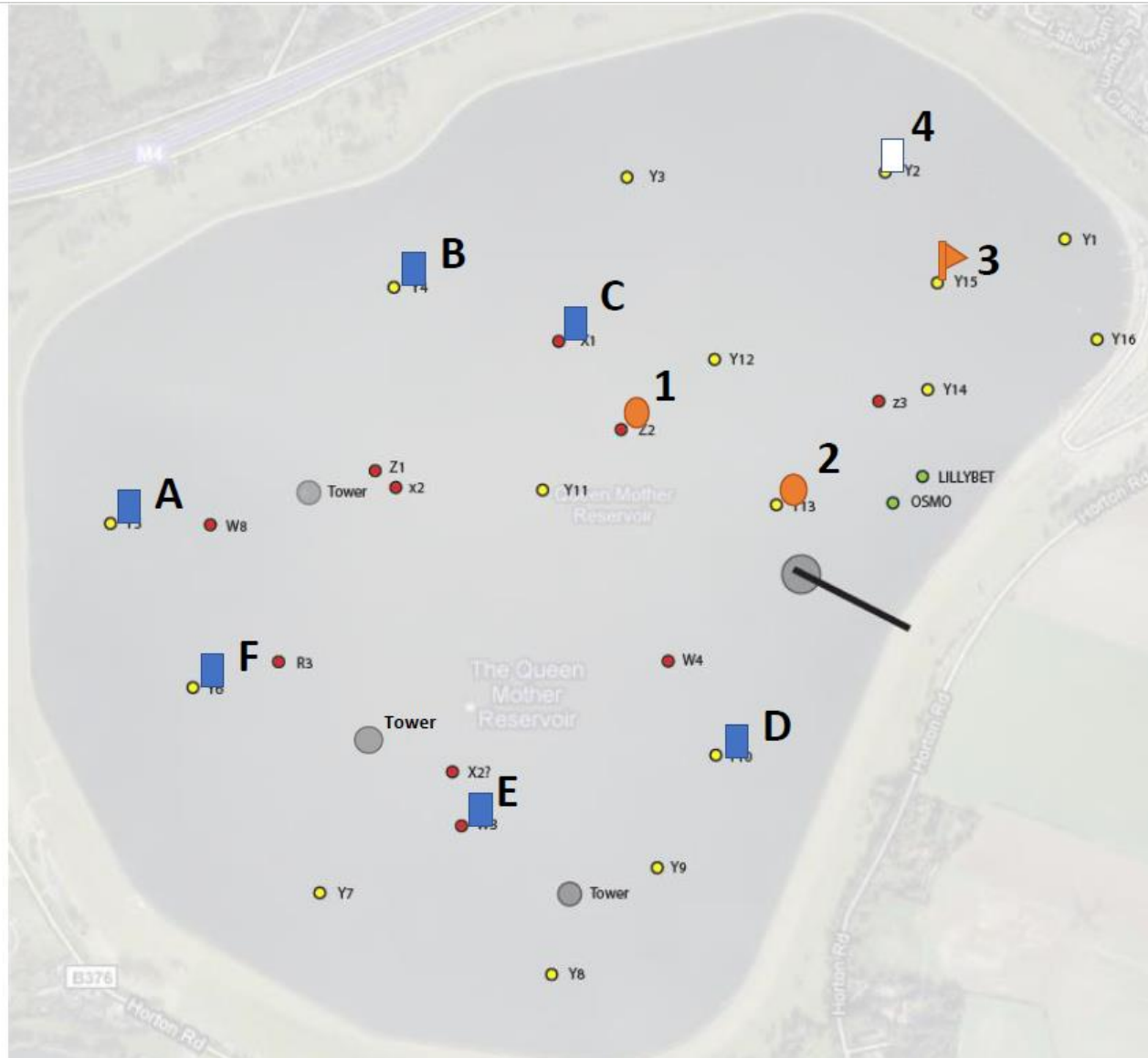
